- 1)** Solve.

$$\frac{x-6}{3} = 7(x+2)$$

- 2)** Write the equation in terms of b .

$$y = ax^2 + bx + c$$

- 3)** Simplify.

$$\frac{11a^5b^{-3}}{c^{-8}} \left(\frac{b^2}{ac^4} \right)^3$$

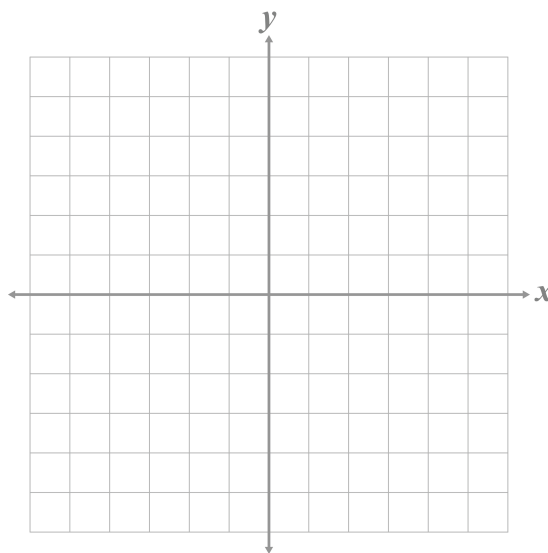
- 4)** Write the answer in simplified radical form.

$$\sqrt{9x^3y^4}$$

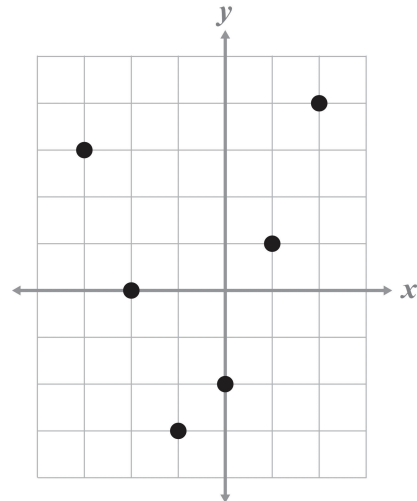
- 5)** Graph.

9) Solve the equation for b .

$$A = bh + 2jk + bk$$

$$\frac{1}{5}(2x - 3) = \frac{3}{2}x - 1$$

$$\{(-5, 1), (-3, -3), (1, -3), (3, -5)\}$$

- 14)** Describe the transformation of the quadratic equation from the parent function.

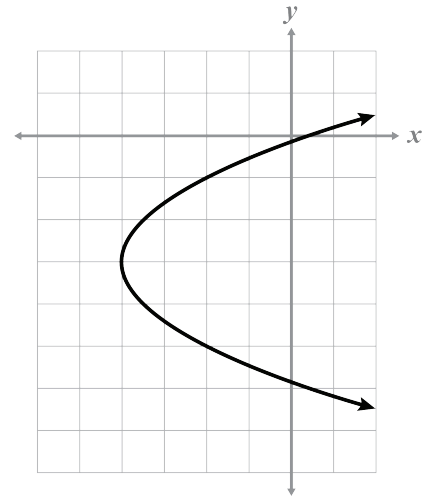
$$y = -(x - 2)^2 + 5$$
