Harvesting Creativity

Embrace the cool, crisp sensations of fall with these Autumn-themed writing prompts. Encourage your students to use rich, descriptive words and to immerse themselves in this season of harvest.

If your student needs some help getting started:

They can make a word bank of descriptive words to use.

Example: Describing the colors of Fall leaves

fiery	scarlet	glowing	dappled	burgundy	veined

Have them answer some questions about their character(s):

Who do they imagine is in the story?

Who else is there?

What are they doing?

Where are they?

Why are they there?

When/what time of day is it?

How did they get there?

Have them imagine the setting:

Weather: sunny, clear, crisp, foggy, misty, chilly, rainy, cloudy, windy, stormy, blustery, snowy

Time of day: moonlit night, dawn, sunrise, morning, noon, afternoon, dusk, sunset, twilight, moonless night

Location: inside, outside, at home, in a forest, on a field, in a tall building, on a rowboat, riding a train, climbing a mountain

Colors: bold, pastel, dark, bright, rainbow, grays, warm, cool

They can also consider: the season, the plants and animals there, the buildings, tools, and vehicles around them, clothing styles, is it the future, present, or past
