## Refreshing Creativity

Rejoice in the fresh renewal of Spring with these Spring-themed writing prompts. Encourage your students to use rich, descriptive words and to immerse themselves in this season of new growth.

### If your student needs some help getting started:

#### Have them make a word bank of descriptive words to use:

Example: Describing new plant growth

green	lime	chartreuse	neon green	refreshing	succulent
vibrant	colorful	bold	fresh	uncurling	crisp
translucent	verdant	seedling	sprig	fragile	tender
shoot	bud	budding	unfolding	resilient	
awakening	blooming	new	young	fresh	

#### Have them answer some questions about their character(s):

Who do they imagine is in the story?

Why are they there?

Who else is there?

How did they get there?

What are they doing?

Is it the past, future, or present?

#### Have them imagine the setting:

What is the weather like?

*(Sunny, clear, crisp, foggy, misty, chilly, rainy, cloudy, windy, stormy, blustery, snowy)*

What time of day is it?

*(Dawn, sunrise, morning, noon, afternoon, dusk, sunset, twilight, moonlit night, moonless night)*

Where is your character?

*(Inside, outside, at home, in a forest, on a field, in a tall building, on a rowboat, riding a train, climbing a mountain)*

Are there colors your character sees?

*(Bold, pastel, dark, bright, rainbow, grays, warm, or cool)*

When does the story take place?

*(Past, present, future)*
